WYANDOTTE FIRE DEPARTMENT ORDINANCE SUMMARY FOR USE OF FIREWORKS

The ignition, discharge and use of consumer fireworks is permissible

1. By an adult (anyone over the age of 18)
2. On private land or real property
3. In a manner so that no part of the fireworks will land on or be deposited on another's property.
4. On the day preceding, the day of, or the day after a national holiday
 - a. New Year's Day, Martin Luther King, Jr. Birthday Day, George Washington's Birthday, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Columbus Day, Veteran's Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day.

NOTE: For 4th of July (Independence Day) 2017

Friday: June 30, 2017 use of Fireworks prohibited
Saturday: July 1, 2017 use of Fireworks prohibited
Sunday: July 2, 2017 use of Fireworks prohibited

Monday: July 3, 2017 permitted to use Fireworks
Tuesday: July 4, 2017 permitted to use Fireworks
Wednesday: July 5, 2017 permitted to use Fireworks

Fireworks are prohibited until the next national holiday (Labor Day)

The ignition, discharge and use of consumer fireworks is prohibited

1. **11-53** By an unsupervised minors (anyone under the age of 18)
2. **11-58** By any person under the influence of alcohol or a controlled substance
 - 1949 PA 300, MCL 256.1d and MCL 257.8b
3. **11-54** On public property
 - Roadways, city parks, parking lots, school property, easements, etc.

4. **11-55** On the land or real property owned by someone other than the person discharging the fireworks unless permission is first obtained from the owner
 - Railroad Right of Way, Church properties, business parking lot, vacant properties, etc.
5. **11-52** On any other days except the day preceding, the day of, or the day after a national holiday.
 - No Person may ignite, discharge or use fireworks between the hours of midnight and 8 am any day (one exception New Year's day 1 am to 8 am)
6. **11-52 (d)** Sky Lanterns may not be used or released within the City of Wyandotte.

NOTE: Cherry Bombs, Silver Salutes, and M-80's are Banned by Federal Law
