Dear Mayor DeSana and City Council Members:

Early this spring, I received numerous phone calls inquiring as to the availability of a location to launch kayaks. Soon after, I contacted Tiffany Van DeHey of Riverside Kayak Connection, 4016 Biddle Avenue, Wyandotte, to discuss this situation.

We then visited possible launching locations in Wyandotte, including the Municipal Boat Ramp and former Wyandotte Boat Club/Yacht Club facility located behind the Henry Ford Wyandotte Hospital. These areas were not conducive for safely launching kayaks.

A meeting was then scheduled with representatives of the Wyandotte Boat Club, Riverside Kayak Connection and myself to discuss possible launching options. After a very informative and lengthy discussion and a site visit, it was the unanimous opinion of this group that the area directly north of the north node located at BASF Waterfront Park would be an excellent location for a kayak and canoe launching site.

We also discussed looking into the possibility of purchasing a floating launch/dock similar to the one used by the Wyandotte Boat Club. It was at this time that Wyandotte Boat Club representatives offered their services to install and remove this dock at the same time as they do their own each spring and fall and provide storage when it is not in the water. Ample parking is available on Pine Street for those using the launch.

A quote in the amount of \$2,256 from Connect-A-Dock, Inc. of Adair, IA, was received to supply a dock measuring 5' x 15'. Funds to purchase this dock are available from Recreation TIFA Account 492-200-850-524.

I believe that the addition of this facility will not only help enhance the use of BASF Waterfront Park to its possible potential but also make available to residents of the Downriver area an excellent place from which to launch their kayaks and canoes.

Your support of this project would be greatly appreciated.
