

As part of our commitment to the safety of our employees and our community, BASF Corporation will conduct a site-wide evacuation drill on Tuesday, October 10th from 10:00-11:00 a.m.

Employees will be crossing Biddle Ave. from the BASF Wyandotte facility located at 1609 Biddle Ave. As a precaution, vehicle traffic on Biddle Ave. from Alkali Ave. to Goddard Rd. will be detoured so that employees may safely cross the road to reach their evacuation meeting points.

All affected businesses will be notified of the drill through our Neighbor to Neighbor outreach program.

What should you do?

- Please avoid travel on Biddle Ave. between Alkali Ave. and Goddard Rd. from 10:00-11:00 a.m. on Tuesday, October 10th.
- Do not join the employees who are practicing the evacuation; we will conduct a head count and need to record accurate numbers.

Evacuation Meeting Points

BASF employees will evacuate in three groups based upon their location on the site.

- Group A – exits South to Silver Shores parking lot (1 James DeSana Dr., between Walnut St. and Mulberry St.)
- Group B – exits West to St. Stanislaus Kostka Church parking lot (266 Antoine St., between 2nd St. and McKinley St.)
- Group C – exits North to the Bentley Conference Center parking lot (646 Biddle Ave., between Labadie St. and Bennett St.)
